

EBHDNA Receives Crime Prevention Grant

The East Buntyn Historic District Neighborhood Association was awarded a \$2,500 grant by the Memphis Area Neighborhood Watch, a division of the Memphis Police Department. This money is to be used to fund a program to encourage the use of Ring video cameras by its members. The program, called “Eyes Watching” will give \$75 rebates to those who purchase and install a Ring doorbell or stand-alone camera.

On the Ring.com website, one can purchase various models of cameras that are easily installed and operated. These cameras are priced from \$199 to \$249 and are virtually complete without any other hardware needed.

“With this program, East Buntyn will be increasing the number of households using video cameras by 33. This will be a significant boost to efforts to keep our neighborhood safe,” said Shannon Langellier, EBHDNA president.

“There have been numerous occasions when photos of crime incidents have aided in the apprehension and prosecution of the perpetrators. Recently one EB neighbor had photos taken by his Ring camera of two men as they stole packages from his front porch. The photos were posted on NextDoor on a Saturday. On the following Monday, another EB neighbor spotted these thieves as they were walking on Poplar Avenue. He notified police and they were arrested and charged. The photos made this possible. And this is just one instance.”

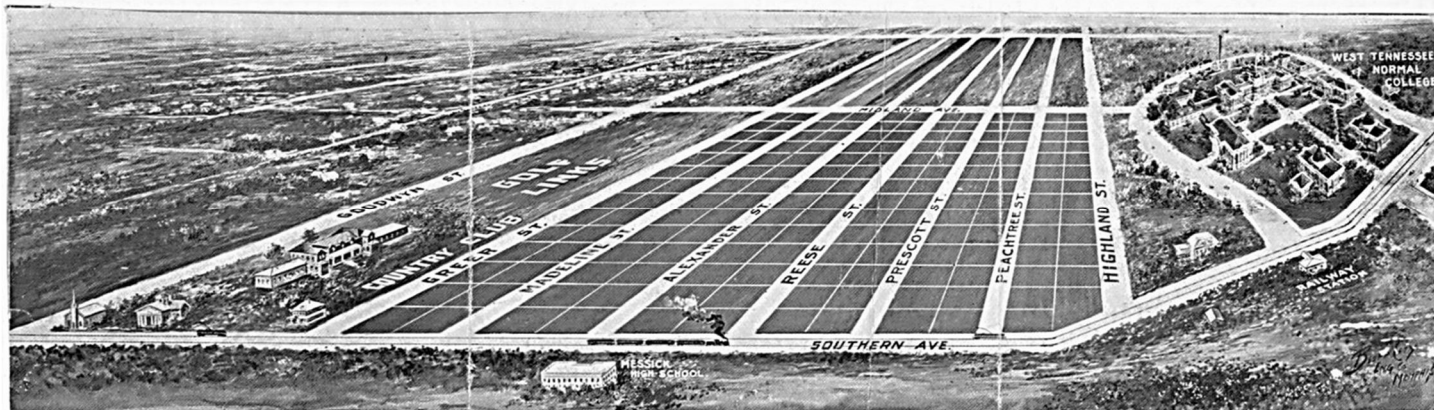
Car Decals Available

From East Buntyn's past.... The Street Formerly Known as Peachtree



On a 1929 map of the city, Ellsworth Street is listed as Peachtree. According to Shelby County historian Jimmy Ogle, the name was changed to Ellsworth in honor of Mr. E.K. Ellsworth, a representative of the U.S. Census Bureau. In 1929, Memphis annexed property to the east of the city limits, which extended the city's reach to Goodlett. This annexation added Buntyn and Normal Station neighborhoods to the city and made Memphis's population climb to over 250,000, which increased the city's eligibility for federal funds. Since his work made the new classification possible, Memphians thanked Mr. Ellsworth by giving him a watch and parade as well as renaming Peachtree Street in his honor.
